

## **HUBBLE FAMILY IN PEMBURY**

*(ALL THE INFORMATION BELOW WAS EXTRACTED FROM DOCUMENTS HELD AT CKS IN MAIDSTONE)*

- 1) Robert – the son of Thomas of Capel  
Married Sarah Hartridge (1746 – 1794) in 1778  
Had 4 daughters incl Charlotte d 1794 aged 10yrs  
died 1804  
1778 – bought ‘Dallies’ (This is Hubbles Farm) and other land in Pembury, of which he was already tenant.  
1780 – taxed on own land, & 2 rented lots from Jones Esq (*owner of Hawkwell*)  
1789 – taxed only on own land  
1790 – had county vote  
1791 - tenant at Copping Crouch Croft (*at Upper Green, next Catholic Church*)  
1793 – described in a mortgage as ‘shopkeeper of Pembury’ (*He seems to be lending the money*)  
1794 – wife died aged 47, & daughter Charlotte aged 10  
1800 – Cuthbert Webb was tenant & RH owner  
1802 – rented ‘Hubbles Farm’ to Cuthbert Webb  
1803 - sold to CW. RH ‘formerly of Pembury but now of Capel’

### **The Will of Robert Hubble 1804** (*Available at CKS, Maidstone*)

Of Five Oak Green.

His heir was nephew Thomas, the son of brother Thomas. Also mentioned were brother William and sister Elizabeth Hods, wdw.

- 2) Thomas the nephew –  
1811 described as ‘gentleman of Capel’ in deeds related to 1793 mortgage  
1814 of Capel had Hunting Licence  
Before 1833 had land near Daly's Well (*This is the ‘Hubbles Farm’ site*)
- 3) Thomas the elder –  
died 1768, Thomas Martin of East Peckham was his executor  
1736 John Lawrence paid rates on ‘Hubels’, so Thomas must have bought it by then.

### **Robert HUBBLE of Yalding left a will** (*At CKS*) died c 1760

Had a godson Robert Hubble (1), the son of Thomas Hubble (3), of Capel yeoman

Had a sister Mary Miller dec'd who had 1 son & 5 daughters who all had legacies:

James, Mary Pett of Elvenden, Ann Marsh of Sturry, Elizabeth Manwaring of Yalding & Sarah Holmes (*Mr Holmes is a Chelsea Pensioner & was not to get his hands on the money*)

James Miller was executor & was to have the residue.

*(This Robert could be the brother of Thomas (3).)*
