1848					A Stephen Sawyer dies in 1848, Tunbridge Wells.

Framfield, 1819	Miller	Hays Mill (transcribed) Could be read as Heys Mill	Census 1851	<p>On the OS map of 1813-19, the wood below 'Herrings Mill Wood' is called 'Hey Wood'.</p> <p>Caleb's wife is stated as Jane Newnham but later censuses show her first name as Philadelphia. There is evidence to suggest that Jane was her middle name.</p> <p>Caleb also has two servants. Could he also have been the owner as well as the occupier?</p> <p>In 1851, John Homewood (former miller) is the 'master miller' at Brenchley windmill.</p>

1881	No occupier		Herring Mill	Census 1881, parish of Pembury	'Herring Mill' is listed below Albans Farm on the 1881 Census and is uninhabited. Nicholas Styles and his family are now living in Batchellor Cottage, Bopeep, Hastings Road. His occupation is Agricultural Labourer.
1886				Kent Burials	Nicholas Styles dies and is buried in Brenchley, All Saints. His residence is stated as Pembury.
